Train Connections

Main connections & Frequency of trains

The main railway Bologna – Verona – Bolzano/Bozen – Brenner – Innsbruck – Munich allows fast connections with all major cities both north and south of the Alps.

Bolzano/Bozen offers daily fast connections with the Eurocity train from and to Verona station. Besides those connections, regional trains depart every hour from and to Bolzano/Bozen. Daily fast connections with the Eurocity train from Bolzano/Bozen to Innsbruck and Munich station and also daily fast connections from Innsbruck and Munich to Bolzano/Bozen.

The Bolzano/Bozen train station is located in the centre of town.
