Congress Key Theme

The Congress is dedicated exclusively to the topic of agritourism ([find out more](#)). The aims of the initiative are: to discuss the state-of-the-art and the future perspectives of this kind of tourism in rural areas worldwide; to establish an agreement on basic characteristics of agritourism; to build a networking platform for scientists and practitioners dedicated to the exchange of experiences and practical issues; to promote agritourism unambiguously worldwide (at local, regional, national and international level). During the congress scientists, practitioners, associations, businesses and other stakeholders involved in the ambit will have the opportunity to discuss the challenges, opportunities and limitations of agritourism.

Content

The Congress organisers invite all interested professionals, practitioners, researchers, public and private institutions, as well as international networks and initiatives related to agritourism to send their paper or poster referring to one of the [Key Themes](#) of the congress or to one of the [Special Sessions](#). We welcome thematic proposals deriving from all kind of disciplines and concerning both basic or applied research. The link to the concept of Agritourism needs to be evident and you are encouraged to keep in mind the criteria listed on the webpage before submitting your proposal. We welcome contributions on interesting practical experiences.

Submission procedure & deadline

Please submit proposals for papers or posters in the form of 250-word abstract in English (text only) through the [Call for Papers Webpage](#) by Monday **19th February 2018** at 11:59 a.m. (Rome Time). Guidelines and detailed information for paper and poster proposals are available on the same page. Selected contributions will be included in the official Programme. Afterwards the authors will have the opportunity to submit a full paper in order to publish it.

Following a review of the Congress Advisory Board, the organizers will decide on acceptance or rejection of the paper or poster; a notification will be sent to the submitter on March 6, 2018 by email. If you have not received an email notification after March 9, 2018, please contact us via e-mail.
